A true thank you to the coaches for their caring help that goes beyond teaching dives. And the greatest of thanks to all the divers in Division II, who have shared their talents with us this season.














QUALIFYING FOR ALL-STARS

The highest three scores (1 through 3) in each event are eligible for the All-Stars meet. The next three finishers (4 through 6) will be the alternates for his/her age group and any one of them will be able to participate in All-Stars if any one of the top three qualifiers are unable to attend.

Divers who placed in the top eight in the previous year's All-Stars meet AND who finish no lower than first alternate (4th Place) in this year's divisional championship meet qualify for the All-Stars meet.

Diving without good eyesight allowed her to build confidence in other athletic skills.
