



Oakton Swim and Racquet Club is located at 11714 Flemish Mill Court, Oakton, Virginia. Parking will be reserved to NVSL officials, Oakton Dive Reps and one parking spot per visiting team. There is plenty of additional parking space on Flemish Mill Ct, as well as the neighboring streets, such as Bronzedale Dr. If parking on Flemish, please do not park on the side of the road marked by orange traffic cones, as it poses a safety hazard to residents. Do not enter the parking lot unless you are dropping off a diver or have a Parking Pass.

PARKING:

As you enter the parking lot you will be greeted by a Parking Attendant:

- **Parents dropping off divers:** move forward and leave your kid in the drop off area, indicated in light red in the map provided. Your child will see a line to check in with NVSL officials, and will follow the line to get into the club. Once you've dropped him/her off, exit the parking lot and park in a nearby location.
- **Parking Pass Holders:** check in with the Parking Attendant and (s)he will direct you to your parking spot. Please, place your Parking Pass on your windshield where it can be seen. As you leave the club, please return your pass to the Parking Attendant. If someone from your team will be using it at a later time, they will just inform the Parking Attendant that the Parking Pass was left with her, and she'll give it to them to put on their windshield. Nobody without a Parking Pass will be allowed to park inside the parking lot.
- **Coaches, Reps, Spectators without a Parking Pass:** please, do not enter the parking lot. Instead, park outside in the neighborhood streets.

CHECK IN:

All divers need to check in before their event with the NVSL officials at the entrance of the pool (represented by the orange tent on the left side on the map).

TEAM TENTS AREA:

We have specific areas for teams and spectators. Towards the end of the club there are large permanent tents where divers and coaches can stay. Each club will be assigned an area on a first-come, first-serve basis.

In front of the permanent tents, there's a reserve zone for teams to set up their tents and chairs. This space is limited, so we ask teams to be considerate with each other. A team with divers competing in just one event might decide not to set up a tent and leave that space for teams with several divers competing in multiple events throughout the day.

We will not be checking how many kids each team has, and will allow tents to be set up on a first-come, first-serve basis in the Tents Area, trusting we will all use our best judgment, camaraderie and care for each other when making the decision.

There will be an overflow area on the top of the hill to the right of our parking lot, where we will allow a limited number of tents and chairs to be set up there, **ONLY** when the area inside of the pool is full. This space is adjacent to the Awards Area.

SPECTATORS SEATING & VIEWING

There are several areas where you can stay while your diver is waiting to compete, or is competing.

Bleachers: this is the prime viewing location. Bleachers are located right in front of the diving boards. Since this seating space is limited, we encourage spectators to only occupy the bleachers while their diver is competing. Otherwise, allow this area to be used by other families.

Shaded Seating Area: chairs will be placed on a shaded area by the baby pool. As you enter the club to your right. Please do not move the chairs, and allow for some rotation in this area, giving priority to families of divers competing in the current event.

Tables with umbrellas: located in front of the shallow area of the pool.

FOOD AND BEVERAGES

Our concession stand will serve food throughout the day, starting with breakfast options, including Anita's burritos, followed by burgers and hot dogs, and an array of snacks.

Additionally, the snack shack will also be open offering beverages, snacks, Rita's Italian Ice, and alternative food options.

Cash and credit cards accepted.

ALL STARS AND DIVING MERCHANDISE

HOSPITALITY ROOM

Oakton Swim & Racquet Club will generously provide a hospitality room for coaches and NVSL officials. This is the perfect place to take a breath, cool off under the AC and enjoy light snacks and beverages.

This is an adult-only area, and is limited only to adults wearing the wristbands provided to each team in their welcome packet.

AWARDS AREA

Awards will be announced after each event (freshman girls, freshman boys...) concludes. After the event is completed, divers will leave the dive well to the right side of the boards near the warm up area.

The Awards area is located on the hill outside the pool, adjacent to the parking lot.

MARSHALLS

We will have marshalls on the pool deck throughout the day to assist in answering any questions, and to help ensure the meet is a success. Marshalls will be wearing orange vests. Be sure to look for them if you need help.
