#### **QUALIFYING FOR ALL-STARS**

The highest three scores in each event are eligible for the All-Stars meet. The next three finishers will be the alternates for his/her age group and will be able to participate in All-Stars if the top three qualifiers are unable to attend.

Divers who placed in the top eight in the previous year's All-Stars meet AND who finish no lower than first alternate (4<sup>th</sup> Place) in this year's divisional championship meet qualify for the All-Stars meet.
