GRADUATING SENIORS

NORAH KISSINGER – (Great Falls)

She took up diving because of her siblings and has always had a love for it. She even started her high school's dive team which she has competed on for the past 2 years while also diving at Alexandria Dive Club. While diving for Oakcrest she won the conference championship 2 years in a row and competed in states both years for diving and swimming.

After graduating from Oakcrest School this year, Norah will be attending the University of Navarra in Pamplona, Spain this fall and she plans to study biochemistry. She also plans to come back and dive next year for her final NVSL season with Great Falls.

Over the years, Caden got better and better and started placing highly in events like divisionals, in fact, this past summer, he was the divisional champion, beating out many accomplished divers 2 years older than him, and with much more experience. This qualified Caden for All-Stars, where he placed 10th, but was only a few points behind the top performers, many of whom were graduated high school seniors.

At age 12, Caden started doing club diving at George Mason Diving Academy and going to camp at the U.S. Naval Academy and kept getting better. With diving, he has no reservations about taking risks and loves to push himself to figure out how to get my body to do seemingly impossible things. He has recently joined a new club diving team and hopes the exposure will be a benefit as he begins to look at colleges over the next year.

There have been times when he has surprised himself by offering others advice and encouragement even in the heat of competition.
