QUALIFYING FOR ALL-STARS

The highest two scores in each event are eligible for the All-Stars meet. The next three finishers will be the alternates for his/her age group and will be able to participate in All-Stars if the top three qualifiers are unable to attend.

Divers who placed in the top eight in the previous year's All-Stars meet AND who finish no lower than first alternate (4th Place) in this year's divisional championship meet qualify for the All-Stars meet.

Additionally, divers who achieve a divisional championship meet score equal to or greater than the average fifth place All-Stars score for their age group (listed below) will qualify for the All-Stars meet regardless of place finish.
