NVSL Dive -- 2024 The Season in Review

3	 Number of Undefeated/Untied Teams Highlands Swim, Woodley, and Parklawn, (5-0-0)

NVSL Dive -- 2024 The Season in Review

 Median winning margin for dual meets (2024) 50% of all 2024 meets were decided by 12 points or less
 Division 7 had dual-champions – AF and RFD Division 8 had tri-champions – HSC, SRA, and OH
 % of all dual meets won by the home team No definitive home/away pool advantage this year (1 tie) Div 5 home teams won 11 of 15 dual meets (highest in the league)
• Over 53% of divers also swim for their pool
• 13 NVSL Dive Teams had at least 24 divers compete from 17 different NVSL pools without dive teams.

NVSL Dive -- 2024 Eleven Season Highlights

- 1. No team was "locked in" as division champion in the final week of competition. Division champions were all decided in the last week of diving.
- 2. Division 1 had 3 teams tied at 3-1 going into the final week. Two of them (DR and VW) met in the last meet and ended in the <u>only tie of the season (36-36)</u>, while OAK won its last meet, making it the Division 1 champion.
- 3. In Division 2, HS maintained a 5-0 record defeating SHR in the last meet.
- 4. In Division 3, FS won their last meet to secure the championship.
- 5. In Division 4 with two 4-0 teams, W defeated HF in the final meet to secure the championship.

Eleven Season Highlights (continued)

- 6. In Division 5, R held on to sole first place, when CP lost its final meet to CH.
- 7. In Division 6, PL defeated WC in a battle of 4-0 teams in the final meet.
- 8. Division 7 also had 3 teams tied at 3-1 going into the final week but ended with DUAL-CHAMPIONS (AF and RFD), since RFD beat NS in a head-to-head meet while AF won its final meet.
- 9. Division 8 had TRI-CHAMPIONS (OH, HSC, SRA), with OH beating SRA in the final meet and HSC also winning its final meet.
- 10. <u>EVERY ONE OF OUR 48 DIVE TEAMS HAD AT LEAST ONE</u> <u>QUALIFIER FOR ALL STARS!</u>

NVSL Dive CrackerJack Meet



- Established in 1987 to provide a skill-appropriate championship meet for beginning divers
- World's largest one-day diving competition
- The first CrackerJack Invitational was held at Freedom Park and attracted approximately 600 divers
- CrackerJack has been hosted by Overlee, Cardinal Hill, Truro, Mansion House, Springfield, Sideburn Run, and Fairfax Station
- Since 2022, CrackerJack has been hosted by Ravensworth
- Divers compete by gender within their age group
 - Age groups are: 6 and Under, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, and 13 and Up
