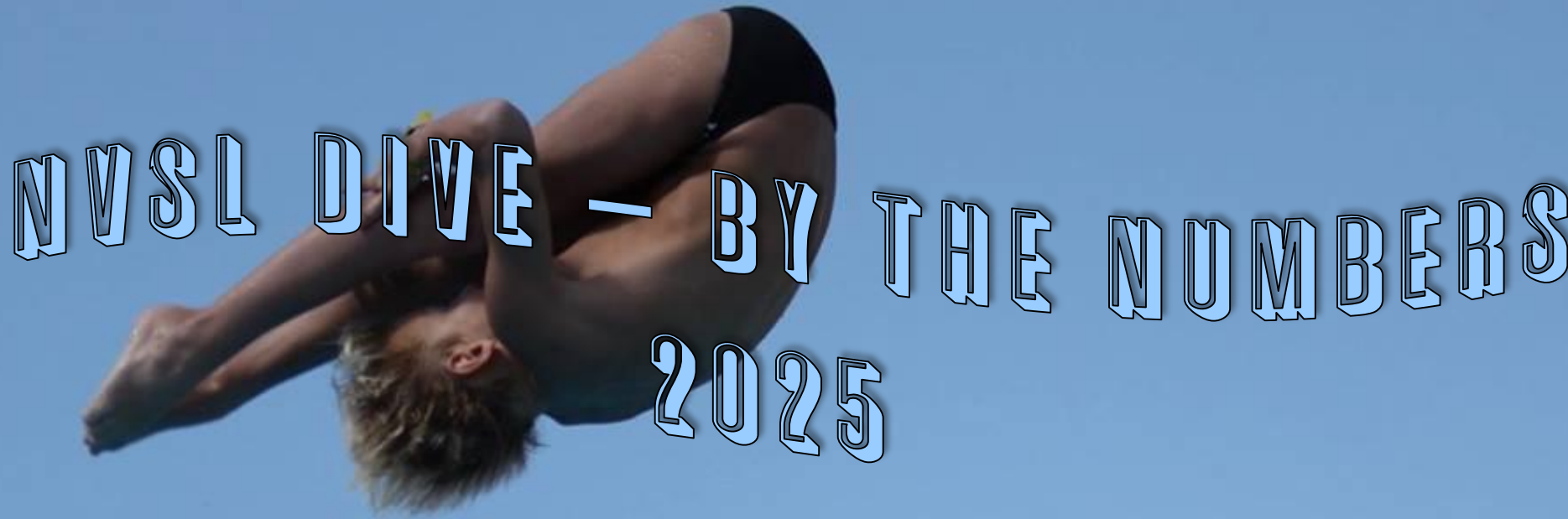

NVSL Dive Statistics

Team Participation

NVSL Dive includes 48 teams, highlighting the extensive involvement of divers, coaches, officials, and parents, and volunteers within the league.

Diver Count

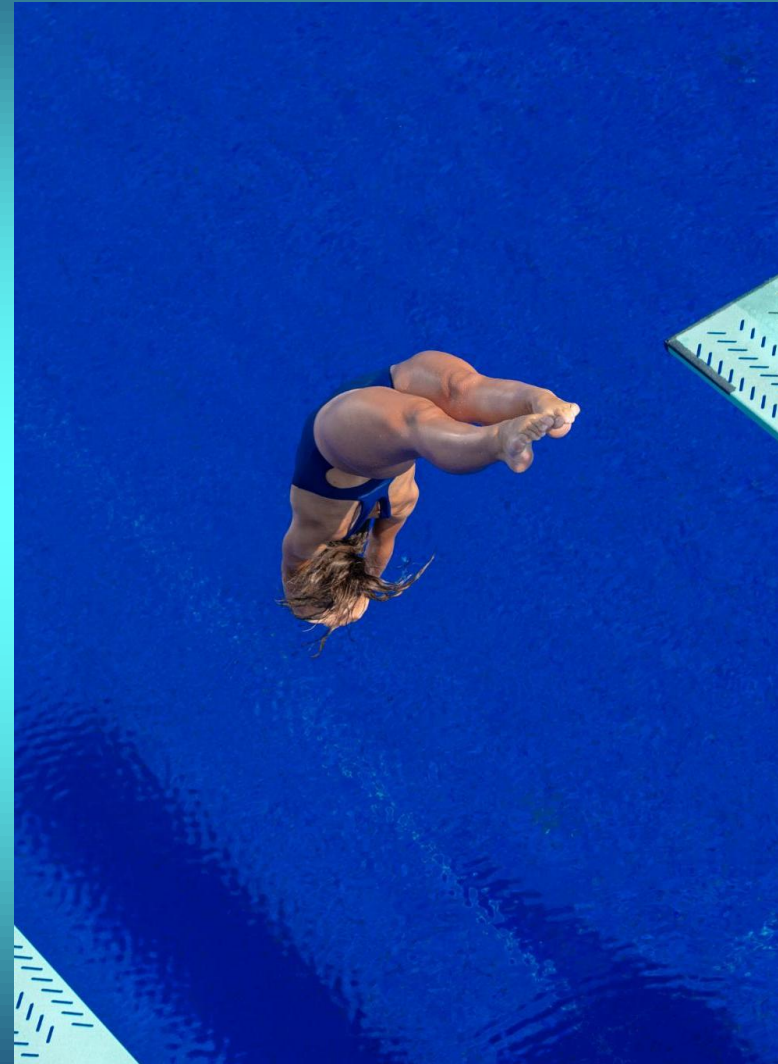
Over 2,100 divers participated in NVSL Dive in 2025, showcasing the large number of both developmental and elite dive athletes in this region.

Meet Frequency

NVSL Dive has 120 dual meets, and 5 championship meets each season, providing numerous opportunities for competition and skill demonstration.

Focus Areas

The NVSL Swim/Dive league emphasizes "A love for the sport, advanced aquatic skills, teamwork, and the principles of good sportsmanship."





NVSL Dive Statistics

NVSL Dive is a *developmental, recreational* dive league, as part of NVSL Swim/Dive, and is composed of 48 community dive pools.

Diver Age

- **NVSL Dive encourages safe diver participation at very young ages**
- **In 2025, NVSL Dive had 3 divers aged 4 years old participating from MHC, NS, and SHB. The 4-year-old diver from NS actually competed in the CrackerJack Championship.**
- **In 2025, NVSL Dive also had 20 divers, aged 5 years old participating from AF, CH, CSC, DR, GF, HSC, KG, O, Oak, OKM, RH, SHB, SHR, SR, SRA, and W.**





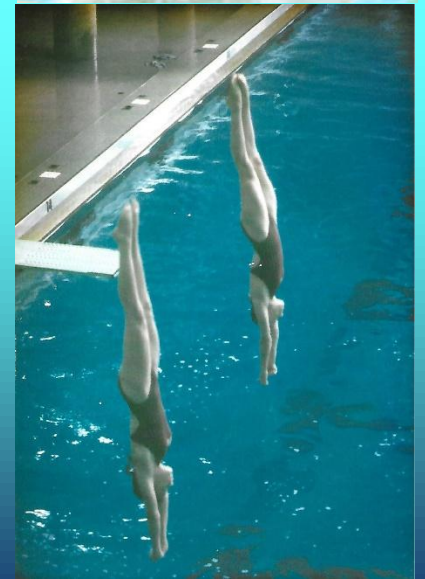
NVSL Dive Statistics

NVSL Dive claims to hold the largest single day Developmental Dive Meet in the country

- In 2025, the CrackerJack meet featured 269 divers in 16 events on a single day
 - Recent years had over 350 divers
 - Two significant weather delays decreased this year's participation

NVSL Dive also claims to hold the largest single day 1-Meter Synchro Dive Meet in the country

- In 2025, the Synchro Meet featured 88 pairs of divers in 4 events on a single day
 - In 2024, we had 83 dive pairs competing

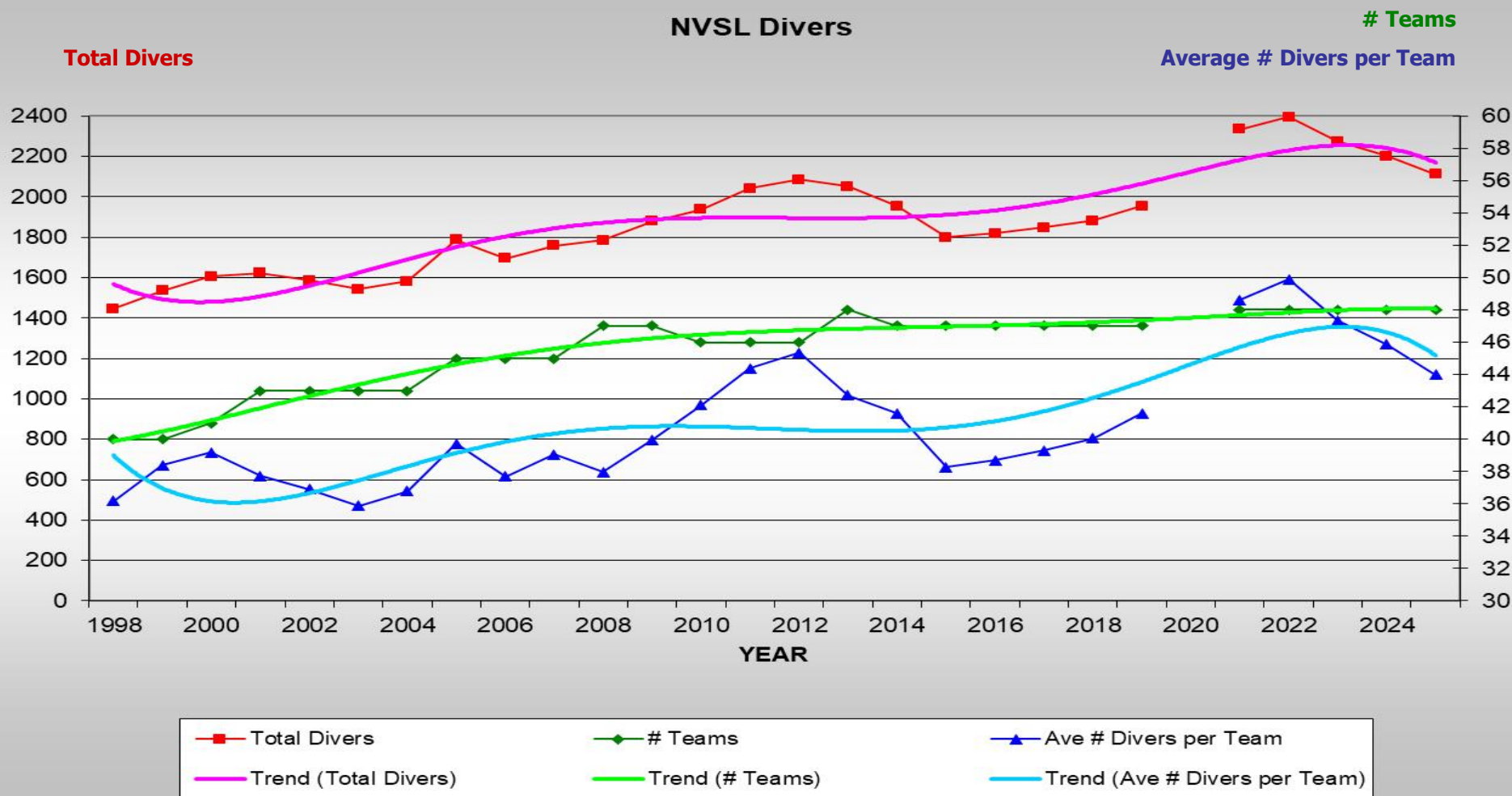

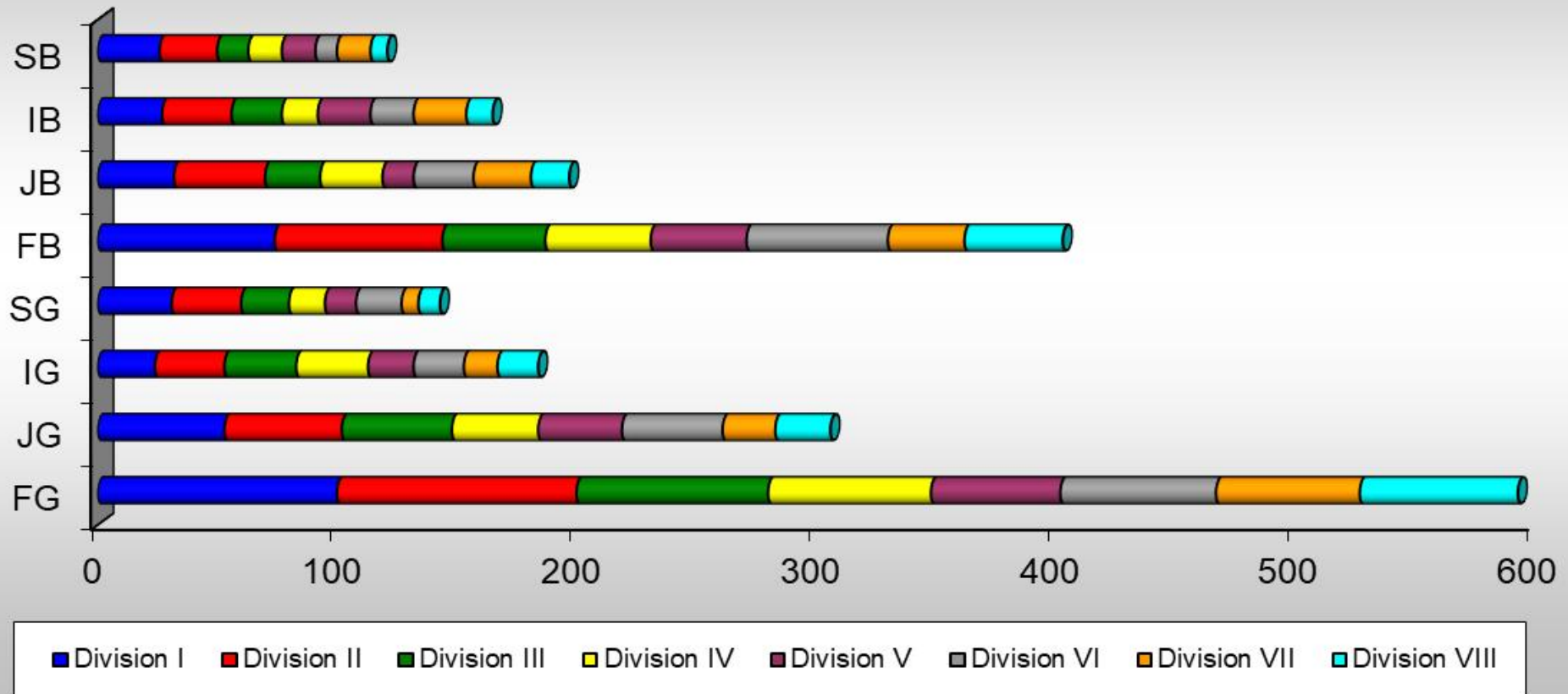

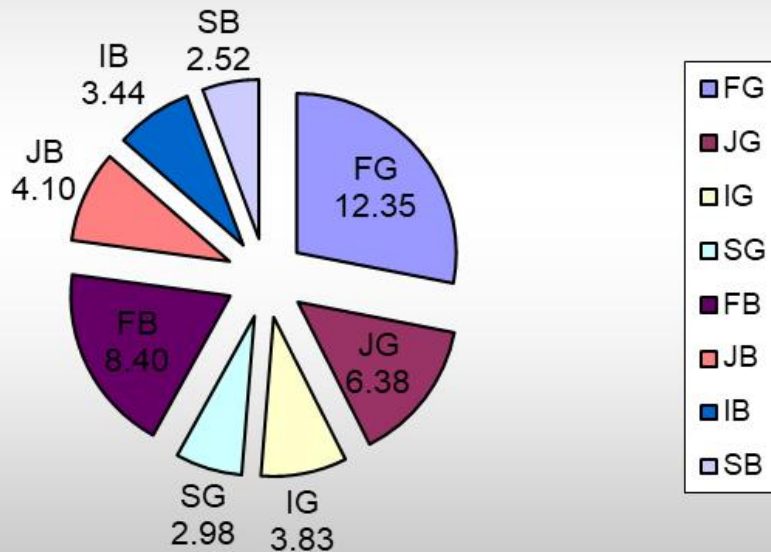




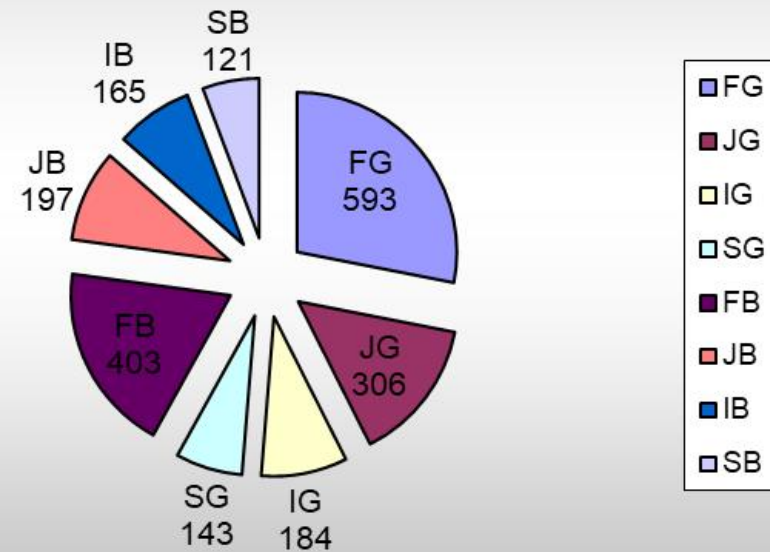

1226 Girls, 886 Boys

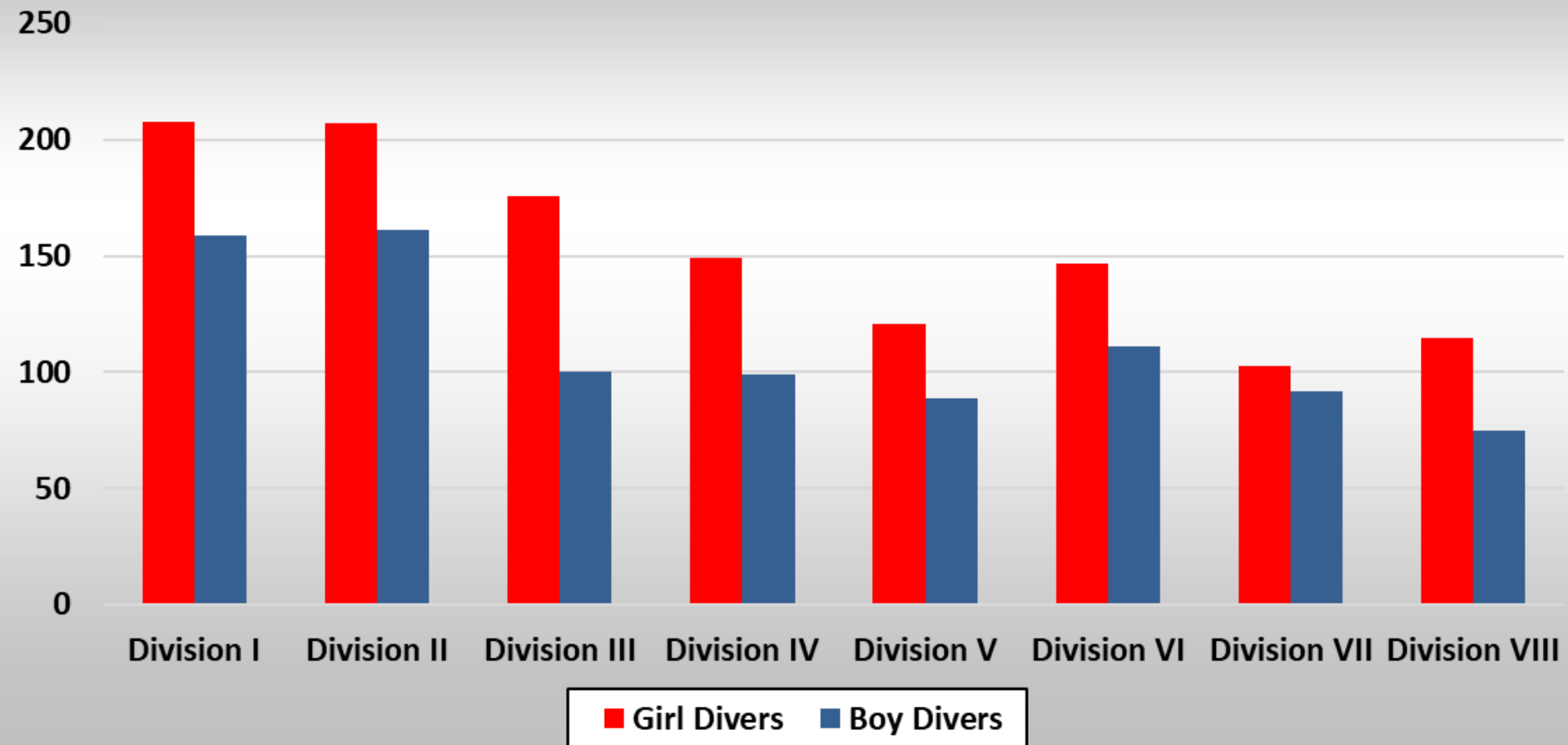

- ***Over 52% of divers also swim for their pool***

- ***18 NVSL Dive Teams had 64 divers compete from 27 different NVSL pools without dive teams.***



NVSL Dive (1998 – 2025)

- ***Number of dual meets ending in a tie score (1998 – 2025; 2960 total meets)***

- ***Number of dual meets decided by 1 point (1998 – 2025)***

58

- ***Largest winning (losing) margin in a dual meet (2010: 65–7)***
 - ***By comparison, the largest winning (losing) margin in a dual meet this year was 45 points (2025: 58—13)***

11

- ***Median winning margin for all dual meets (1998 – 2025)***
 - ***Median for 2025 dual meets was 12 points***

4

- ***170 dual meets have been decided by exactly 4 points, the most likely score difference (or statistically, the mode)***

- 3. Parliament (Division 2) had 2 ties. There were 5 total ties in the league***
- 4. 64 divers competed in NVSL Dive meets from 27 different NVSL pools who do not have dive teams of their own.***
- 5. The Synchro Meet was held for the first time on the Tuesday between Divisionals and All Stars and had a record 88 pairs participating.***
- 6. 47/48 Dive Teams qualified at least 1 diver for All Stars***
- 7. 47/48 Dive Teams had at least 1 diver participate in All Stars***

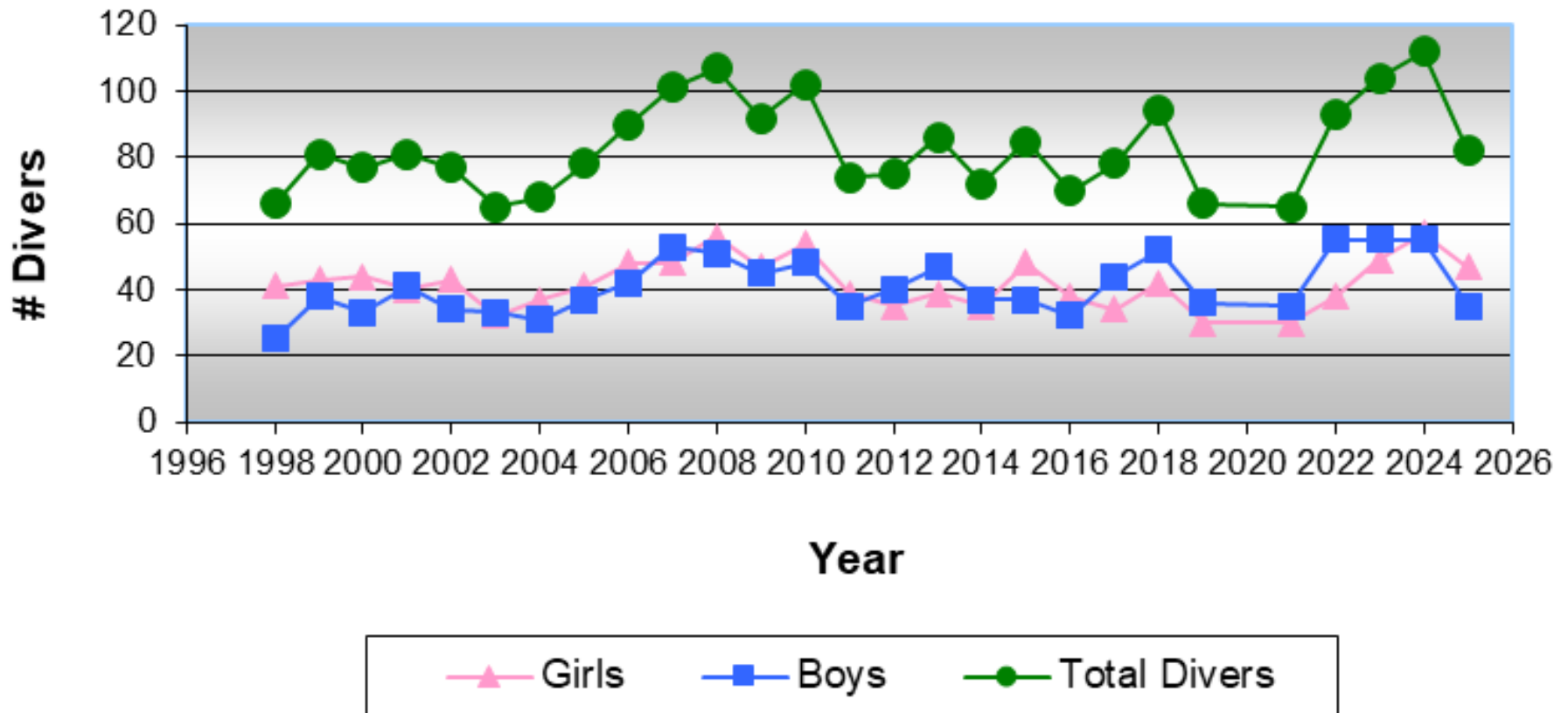

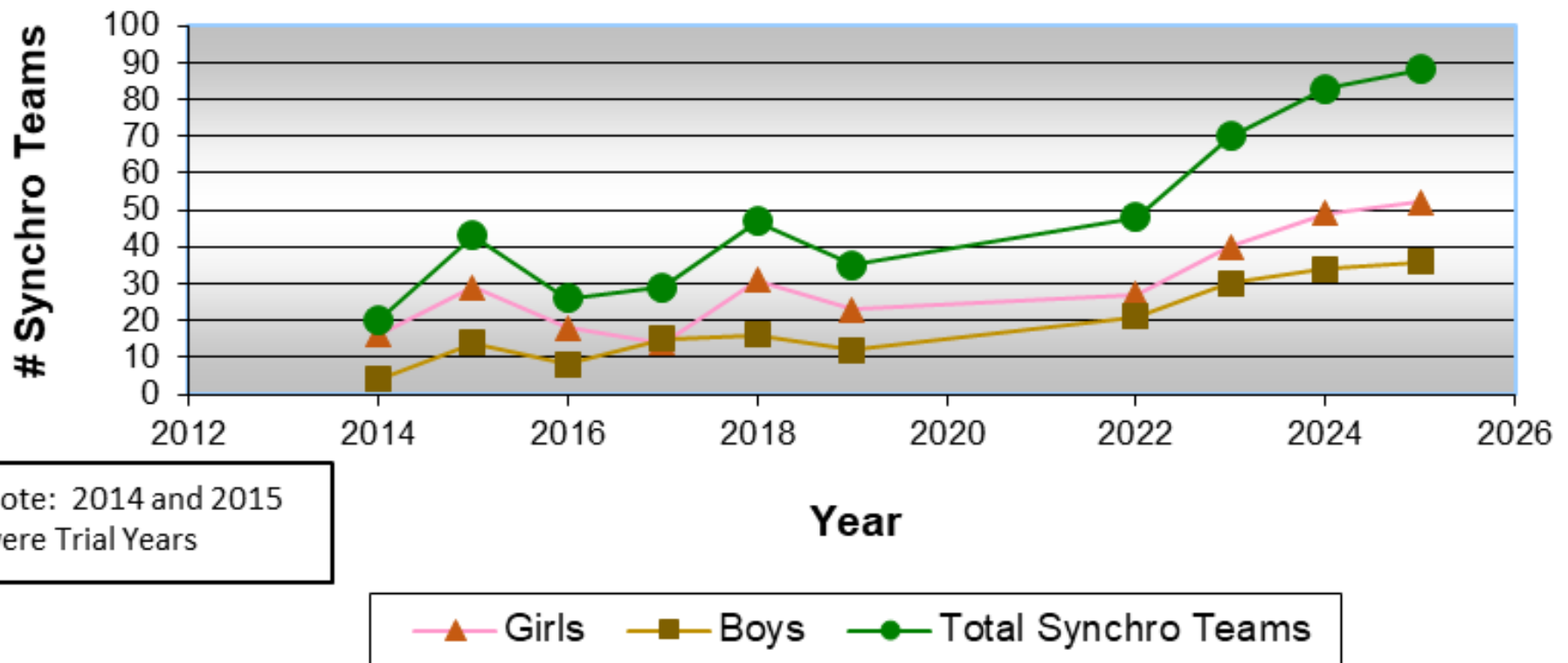

NVSL Dive CrackerJack Meet



- ***Established in 1987 to provide a skill-appropriate championship meet for beginning divers***
- ***World's largest one-day diving competition***
- ***The first CrackerJack Invitational was held at Freedom Park and attracted approximately 600 divers***
- ***CrackerJack has been hosted by Overlee, Cardinal Hill, Truro, Mansion House, Springfield, Sideburn Run, Fairfax Station, and Ravensworth***
- ***In 2025, CrackerJack was hosted by North Springfield***
- ***Divers compete by gender within their age group***
 - ***Age groups are: 6 and Under, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, and 13 and Up***

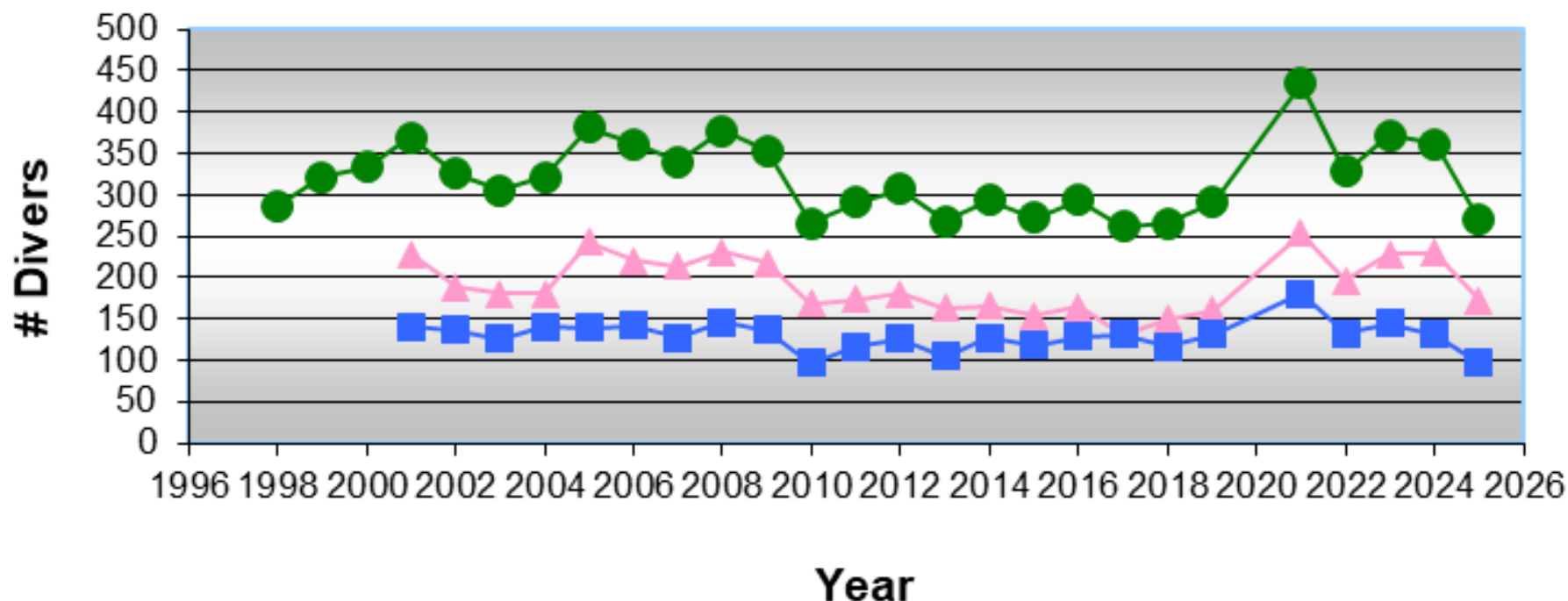

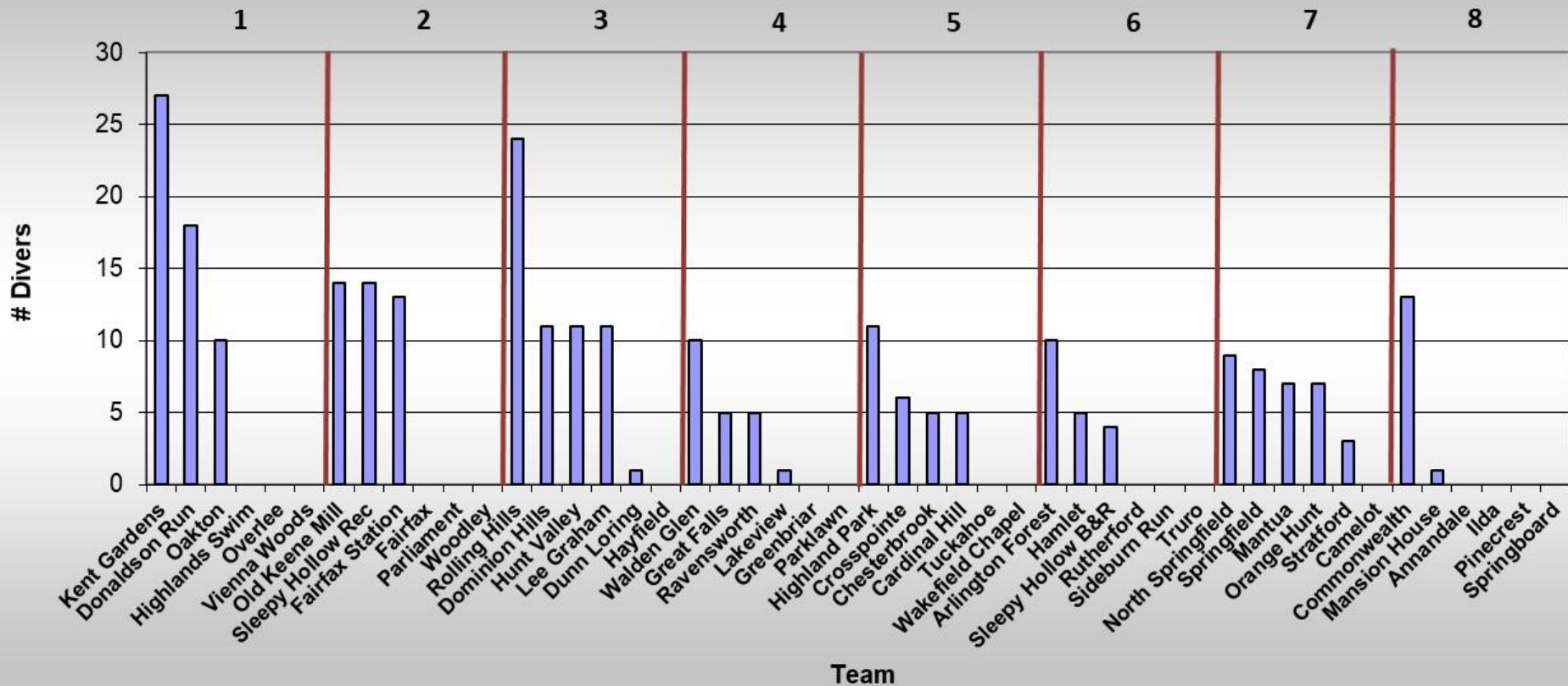
Girls Boys Total Divers
