ELIGIBILITY: The Cracker Jack meet is intended to provide a skill-appropriate championship for beginning divers who have not exceeded the following cut-off scores at an A meet this season:

FG 67	JG 99	IG 136	SG 155
FB 65	JB 95	IB 129	SB 155

All participants in this meet must currently be on a family membership at an NVSL pool and listed on the 2026 dive team roster. All divers must dive in their own age group as shown in the schedule below. Age is determined as of June 1 of the current season.

NOTE: *Competing in the Cracker Jack meet disqualifies a diver from the divisional meet.*

Each group will have a 15-20 minute warm-up before their event start time.

Check-in will open at 7:00 a.m. Warm-up will open for age 6u girls and age 9 girls only at 7:30 a.m.

MEET REGISTRATION: Registration will be online and include electronic dive sheet submission. It will open on Wednesday, July 15 at noon and close on Friday, July 17 at 9 p.m. Instructions will be provided before registration opens.

RULES: Rules are more relaxed for this meet. Age groups 6 & under through 10 do three dives, and age groups 11 & up do four dives. Jumps are allowed in all age groups. Coach-assisted dives are allowed on 101, 201, 401, 001, 002, 100, 200 only. Please see the [Cracker Jack Ruleset](#) for more info.

AWARDS: Medals for places 1-6; ribbons for places 7 & up.

NOTE: The North Springfield dive well is 10 feet deep. It will be overfilled a few inches for the meet.
